Our Parish Neighbourhood Plan, which has been worked on by volunteers in the community for the past 7 years, is moving towards its final stage. Hambleton District Council is calling for comments in accordance with Regulation 16 consultation rules.

The consultation period has been extended to **5.15pm on Monday 1st March**, after which comments will not be considered.

The aim of our Neighbourhood Plan is **to empower residents to have a say** over what happens here, **not just now, but in the future.** Making decisions about what our community needs in terms of housing and not being at the mercy of big developers is at the heart of the Plan.
