A resident expressed concern regarding the stable block being built at Arncliffe House. It was thought it may be larger than originally agreed during the planning process. The Parish Council will contact HDC and request that an inspection is carried out.

Matters arising from last meeting

Winter Gritting Upgrading – we have had a reply to our request for upgrading our level of priority. NYCC have refused our request. The Parish Council will continue to lobby for this. In the meantime we will look into a possible alternative way of having some village roads gritted.

Ordnance Survey Maps – we now have the log in details for the PSMA area of the website which enables use of the maps.

Parish Council Vacancy – we have had two expressions of interest. After the cut-off date, the prospective councillors will be invited to the next meeting and a vote taken.

Matters arising this meeting

Community Plan – this has been well received and thanks were expressed to those responsible for the work involved in drawing up and circulating the plan. The Parish Council is required to make a contribution to the printing costs of £37.80

Neighbourhood Watch — The latest report has been put on our villages' website.

Winter preparations – emergency procedures. Mrs Warhurst reported on the Parish Liaison meeting she attended. It was suggested that we put in place a system of help for those in need of support during extreme conditions. Age UK have a very useful booklet 'Spread the Warmth' on how to stay warm in winter.
