2. Opportunity for Public to Speak.

5.3. Good Neighbourhood Scheme.

This scheme seems too big for our small parish council to take on board; we do have a scheme where the pc has numbers of volunteers who will be available for anyone who cannot get out or need shopping or medicines picking up.
