4.1. Neighbourhood Plan Update

4.2 Community/Parish Website

5. Matters Arising this Meeting

5.1. Stokesley and Villages Community Neighbourhood Plan.

We had been sent a template and Mrs Warhurst suggested that councillors might like to respond to her with issues relevant for this parish. We could feed the

information back at the next meeting of the Stokesley and Villages Community Regeneration Group.

5.2. Open Gardens Weekend.

This was a great success, £5,750 was made for the event. 9 groups benefited, each receiving £517.50.

5.3. Printing extra copies of Community Plan.

Twenty-five copies will be ordered at a cost of about £25. These will be given to new residents in the village.
